



The Richmond Arms Hotel started out as the "Lennox Arms" in 1827, which was possibly named after the Duke of Richmond in the UK. The Hotel was constructed by James Buscombe in 1827, and was a stop off point for much needed food and refreshments in an enjoyable and affable country location, for weary and tired travellers on their way through to Hobart Town by coach and horse, or on foot. As it is today, The "Richmond Arms Hotel" was an integral part of the country community, with Election results even being called out from the top of the veranda to the village residents gathered below! Now local residents enjoy the warmth and hospitality and food inside to closely monitor the results on Election night, or enjoy a celebration, commiseration or catch up with friends and family for a good time. The "Lennox Arms" was destroyed by fire in 1888, and was rebuilt. It was renamed in 1972, as the "Commercial Hotel", and then rebadged "The "Richmond Arms Hotel" which was more suitable being situated on the main street, in the pretty and quaint village of Richmond. The "Richmond Arms Hotel" is owned by a local Coal River Valley 6th Generation Tasmanian farming family, who along with the friendly Hotel Manager Casey and staff, thank you for your patronage today.
